## E-SLP project on Short Learning Programmes

Increasingly universities use online/blended Short Learning Programmes (SLPs) as a flexible and scalable offering to serve large numbers of students, needed to close the knowledge and skills gap in Europe. SLPs also keep innovative knowledge and skills of workforce up to date and better anticipate on careers of tomorrow than degree programmes. To increase the awareness and uptake of SLPs, EADTU together with 14 university partners started in January 2018 the European Short Learning Programmes (E–SLP) project for continuous professional development and lifelong learning under EC's Key Action 3 Forward–Looking Cooperation projects. ## **EMPOWERing University of West Bohemia**

In the context of the EMPOWER programme international experts in online and blended learning visited the University of West Bohemia on 24–25 January. During the Rector's meeting they presented several case studies and scenarios for digital teaching and learning at the University of West Bohemia. In additional seminars various key–issues for successful implementation of new modes of teaching were discussed at management and staff level.

New Goals (NG) is a three-year programme by the eLearn Center (eLC), aimed at developing the UOC's strategic lines of translational research in e-learning. The field of research for this first edition centres on Intelligent Tutoring Systems and their potential effects on students' learning processes.

People participating in the NG programme will come from an international call for applications for principal investigators. The resulting team will be an international leader and help generate new and significant knowledge in experimentation.

## A New Platform for Learning Turkish from Anadolu University Open Education System



Ana-dil Türkçe is a new distance-learning project that Anadolu University has developed to teach Turkish. Among the target audience of the project are about 90 thousand foreign nationals studying in Turkey, about 3.1 million immigrants in Turkey and anyone aspiring to get familiar with the Turkish culture and language. The platform allows learners to study at their own pace independent of time and place by means of modern learning technologies. Learning materials are currently designed to teach Turkish at A1/A2 level, but will be enhanced to cover higher levels.

Bridging the gap between theory and practice UOC Training course: Responsible Research & Innovation (RRI) for Researchers.

The RRI framework is gaining momentum as a strategy to align scientific and technological progress with socially desirable and acceptable ends. When turned into daily practice, the RRI concept reports certain difficulties derived from its ambiguity that hampers its implementation.


The new rectorate authorities are expected to take office from February 1, 2018.

# New vice-President for Academic Affairs at the Open University of Israel

Since January 1st 2018 Prof. Sarah Guri–Rosenblit has become the Vice–President for Academic Affairs at the Open University of Israel. The Open University of Israel was established in 1974, based on the model of the UK Open University. It is now the largest university in Israel with about 47,000 students. Prof. Guri–Rosenblit got her PhD from Stanford University in 1984 in education and political science. Her areas of expertise are focused on comparative research of higher education systems, distance education and e–learning. She published books and multiple articles in these fields and was invited as a keynote speaker to dozens of international conferences worldwide. She is currently a member of the Future University Network which is composed of higher education researchers trying to depict and envision future university manifestations of both campus–based and distance teaching universities.
