Open Education System of Anadolu University now offers programs in English

In 2017–2018 academic year, the Open Education System of Anadolu University starts offering programs in foreign languages in addition to programs in Turkish. This will allow Anadolu University students to earn internationally acknowledged degrees.

The subjects offered in English are International Relations and Business Administration. Both programs admit students in 2017–2018 academic year. Students that complete the study successfully have the chance to pursue graduate studies abroad with their internationally acknowledged degrees. To prove English proficiency, candidates are required to submit score reports of tests recognized by the Higher Education Council of Turkey.

IN-CLOUD project improving EU SMEs competitiveness

The IN-CLOUD project aims at training new professionals that can introduce into European Companies and Public Administrations, and manage, cloud technologies and systems.

The final project meeting, held in Rome on June 2017, paved the way to the launching of the 4 professional qualifications designed for the project:

- ·Cloud professional for business
- ·Cloud professional for education and training
- ·Cloud professional for public administration
- ·Cloud technology professional

These qualifications are fully on-line and based on video lectures, interviews to experts and other resources. Additionally, learners not interested on getting the certifications can participate in a virtual boot camp that fits any learner's preferences.

OUC accepted as member of EJTA

Open University of Cyprus (OUC) is the first open and distance University unanimously accepted to join the European Journalism Training Association (EJTA). OUC will be represented in the association by its postgraduate programme "Communication and New Journalism".



More than 60 journalism centers, faculties and universities from 24 European countries are currently members of EJTA, whose main objective is to improve journalism education in Europe, enabling members to collaborate on exchanges, teaching and research projects, to stimulate European co-operation in journalism education and mid-career training between non-profit training centers, and to develop a professional approach towards journalism training.




Honorary doctorate
