

CPL study: MOOC strong enabler innovation

EADTU and its members have conducted a follow-up study on the Changing Pedagogical Landscape (CPL), identifying patterns in policies and practices of new modes of teaching and learning. The report observes an accelerated uptake of digital education at various levels. In this respect, MOOCs have proven to be a strong enabler for innovation in mainstream degree education and in continuous education/CPD.



MOOC strand OOFHEC2018

On 10–12 October, the Online, Open and Flexible Higher Education Conference 2018 takes place at Aarhus University (DK), with a specific strand on MOOCs and Open Education. It shows that many institutions and regions in Europe are actively

involved in MOOCs, driven by different aims and objectives. During the conference a plenary sessionwill be dedicated to the role of MOOC in CPD with three keynotes.



LWMOOCs V conference

On 26–28 September the fifth Learning with MOOCs conference will be held in Madrid. It will be a very interactive program with keynotes, lightning speakers and over 30 presentations of selected papers out of over 100 accepted for publication. OpenupEd and EMC partners are strongly represented in the program.



BizMOOC Conference Krakow

The BizMOOC project organises a one day conference in Krakow on 8 November 2018.

Webinars OpenupEd

On September 18th, OpenupEd contributed to a series of webinars during the EADTU Webinar week: Quality in Higher Education. Six presentations were held presenting different perspectives on quality frameworks of MOOCs, ranging from students and

institutional perspectives, quality processes at FutureLearn and FUN and quality assurance process in cross-sectoral/-institutional teams. Recordings are now available. UOC MOOC on Infographics and Data Visualization

The UOC (Universitat oberta de Catalunya) is running its first MOOC on Infographics and Data Visualization. In a world where visual elements are of growing importance, knowing how to communicate data is increasingly seen as a key skill. In fields such as journalism, statistics and scientific research, data visualization is required to illustrate large quantities of information. This MOOC will shine light on how to present data and how to interpret information shown in graphics. It will also teach participants how to create infographics, ie visual representations of information.

Learning to Learn Online (LTLO) allows novice online learners to explore how online education differs from traditional classrooms. Through readings, activities, and a supportive community of facilitators and fellow learners, participants in LTLO will develop strategies for overcoming common misconceptions, frustrations, and fears to achieve online learning success.
