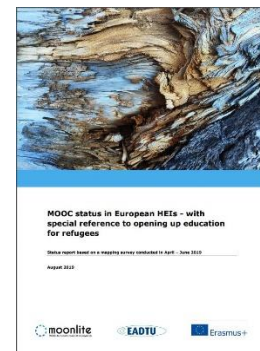


MOONLITE report on MOOC status in European HEIs

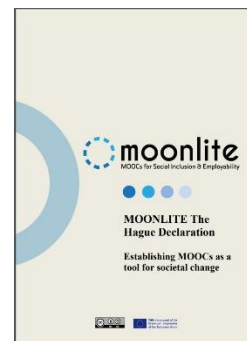
